## **Michael Jackson, international music award**

### LEGEND MUSIC AWARDS

#### GIVE A PRIZE TO MICHAEL JACKSON

In the past February 14th, during the first Michael Jackson Official European Convention in Milan, Legend Music Awards – Jam Music Production Int. announced the arrival to Italy of a member of the Jackson family invited to take the International Music Award conferred by the Association to the King of Pop in 2009.

Legend Music Awards announce now that the event will take place on April 18th 2010, in Milan, at 4.30 pm, and will guest Marlon Jackson, brother of the pop star, already member of the Jackson 5, who will take the prestigious award on behalf and in memory of the famous artist died on the past June 25<sup>th</sup>.

The important acknowledgement intends to highlight the extraordinary artistic career and the huge humanitarian commitment of Michael Jackson during his life.

In fact the peculiar characteristics for the assignment of the award are two: a career of at least twenty years, or the sale of over 40 million records, combined with an evident humanitarian commitment for the weaker ones, and we know that the King of Pop, more than any other music star, has definitely reached these targets.

The no-profit association, Legend Music Awards, by means of the assignation of this award to the career, conferred in the past year also to the Italian artist Laura Pausini, wants to sustain important humanitarian actions. For this first edition a video was produced with which these two artists will produce, once more, active charity through their music, a video which includes a number of never or rarely seen contributions.

Produced and strongly wanted by the Association the Premio Internazionale della Musica Legend Music Awards 2009 video will be broadcasted on a streaming platform, associated to a telephony partner: the users will be able to watch it on their own computer by submitting a little contribution offered to two benefit actions: the research on Multiple Sclerosis by the Reparto di Neuroscienze of the Ospedale San Raffaele in Milan and the Thiemping Senegal Association committed in the building of an medical ambulatory in the nearing of Thiemping.

The event will take place in the Gran Canaria hall at the Hotel Melià in Milan and provides for the participation of a small number of selected persons, which will be able to access the program in the afternoon (strictly reserved) after paying an entry ticket.
